

B.Sc NURSING COURSE

1. What is B.Sc Nursing?

Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.Sc Nursing) is a 4-year undergraduate professional course that trains students to become skilled nurses. The course includes theory + practical + internship and prepares students for careers in hospitals, clinics, and community health services.

2. Course Duration

4 Years (8 Semesters)

Includes 6 months compulsory internship

3. Eligibility Criteria

To apply for B.Sc Nursing, you must have:

- ✓ 10+2 (Science Stream) – Physics, Chemistry, Biology (PCB)
- ✓ Minimum 40–45% marks
- ✓ From a recognized board

Age Limit

- Minimum: 17 years
- Maximum: 35 years
- Married candidates are also eligible in most states.

5. Salary After B.Sc Nursing

Starting Salary

₹18,000 – ₹35,000 / month (private hospitals)

₹40,000 – ₹65,000 / month (government)

Experienced Nurses

₹50,000 – ₹1,00,000+ per month

Abroad (after clearing exams like NCLEX, IELTS, OET)

USA: \$60,000 – \$1,00,000 / year

Canada: CAD 45,000 – 80,000 / year

UK: £24,000 – £35,000 / year

Gulf countries: ₹60,000 – ₹1.5 lakh / month

GNM (General Nursing & Midwifery) COURSE

✓ What is GNM?

GNM is a 3-year diploma course in Nursing designed to prepare students to become clinical nurses, capable of providing patient care in hospitals, clinics, and community health centers.

After GNM, students can work as Registered Nurse (RN) after registration with the State Nursing Council.

❖ Course Duration

3 Years + 6 Months Internship

- 1st Year: Basic sciences + fundamentals of nursing
- 2nd Year: Medical-surgical nursing, mental health nursing
- 3rd Year: Child health nursing, midwifery
- Internship: Hands-on clinical practice

⌚ Eligibility Criteria

To apply for GNM, you must have:

Educational Qualification

- ✓ Passed 10+2 in any stream (Science preferred)
- ✓ Minimum 40–45% marks
- ✓ From a recognized board

Age Limit

- Minimum: 17 years
- Maximum: 35 years
- Married candidates are also eligible in most states.
